The Ross Township Board of Trustees met in regular session to transact business for Ross Township.

ROLL CALL

PROCEDURAL ACTION

<u>Motion 14-034</u> Upon motion by Trustee Yordy and seconded by Trustee Willsey, the Board voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 6, 2014. The vote of the Board shows as follows: All present voted yes, which motion carried.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Administration -

He also asked that the Board consider passing the upcoming Arcadia Business Group resolution. The resolution will allow the Arcadia Business Group to comply with current HIPPA regulations while administering COBRA insurance on behalf of the Township.

Finally, he asked that the Board consider passing the upcoming resolution to increase the General Fund revenue by \$448,651.21 through an estate settlement.

Fire Department - Chief Steve Miller recapped a meeting he had with Medicount Management regarding EMS billing and revenue. The Board advised that they were pleased with the current billing practices.

Road Department - Superintendent Paul Bulach suggested that the Board consider passing the upcoming ODOT salt purchase resolution. The resolution will allow his department to purchase 100 tons of salt to repay the agencies which kindly allowed Ross to borrow salt to combat previous winter storms while our supply was exhausted.

He further advised that under ORC Section 5553.045 the closure of Wade Mill and Canary cannot occur without a vacation of the right-of-way unless the closure is temporary for safety purposes or during construction. He stated that a July, 2012 review of the river bank erosion problem by Rich Cogen from the Ohio River Foundation found that the gravel company operation was in compliance with the permit issued by the Army Corp of Engineers. The Board instructed him to secure the

safety of the curve with concrete barricades, ask the County Engineer if the situation qualified for a temporary closure and continue to research if anything can be done to eliminate the river bank erosion prior to a decision to close the roads and vacate the right-ofway.

He also advised that the department will be working to resolve a stream bank erosion problem on both Warvel and Herman Roads and listed the street work to be performed under the 2014 crack sealing and rejuvenation contracts.

Finally, he reported that Truck #3 is in need of a \$15,000 repair to the exhaust and turbo systems and its' repair is not cost effective. The truck has been taken out of service and will become part of a future auction.

Police Department - Chief Darryl Haussler suggested that the Board consider passing the upcoming motion to hire Jack L. Tremain, Renee M. Lutterbie, and Nicholas A. Lutterbie to the position of Part-time Police Officer pending successful completion of all pre-employment testing. He also provided an update on the interview process for the School Resource Officer position and advised that he has accepted the resignation of Lieutenant Mike Broughton.

He requested the Boards opinions regarding possibility of purchasing the services of the Lexipol Company for his departments Standard Operation Procedures. Trustee Willsey will check with the OTA to see if they offer this service. If not, the Board concurs with the purchase of the Lexipol service.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Resident Jerry Hilbert suggested the use of a "jersey barrier" to fix the problem on Wade Mill and Canary. The Board instructed the Administrator to look into that option and thanked Mr. Hilbert for his input.
