



ROSS TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NUMBER 2017-026

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A NEW ROSS TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT LEXIPOL POLICY MANUAL

WHEREAS, at Resolution 11-39, the Ross Township Board of Trustees adopted comprehensive Personnel Policies to assist Ross Township employees in answering questions they may have regarding Township operations; and

WHEREAS, in order that the Township provide Police Department policies and procedures and to assist Ross Township employees in answering questions they may have regarding Township operations.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Ross Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1-A:

That the Board of Trustees hereby adopts the Ross Township Police Department Lexipol Policy Manual in its completed form, the Cover Page and Table of Contents to which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 1-B:

That the Ross Township Police Department Lexipol Policy Manual is hereby adopted as a supplemental document to the Ross Township Personnel Policy (Current Edition).

SECTION 2:

This resolution shall take effect on June 15, 2017, following the filing of this resolution with the Ross Township Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 3:

It is hereby determined that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board of Township Trustees and that all deliberations of such Board of Trustees were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

INTRODUCTION AND VOTE RECORD:






